


Kozmo Hotel Suites & Spa, a reinterpretation of classic luxury

Introducing Kozmo Hotel Suites & SPA *****, a member of the Leading Hotels of the World organization.

A masterful blend of historical tradition and modernity - this is what Kozmo embodies: an exquisite five-star venue with a clean contemporary décor that offers a sense of classic luxury within historic walls. The Kozmo Luxury Hotel Budapest is an architectural jewel - the legendary landmark that houses Kozmo was built in 1917 as Hungary's largest telecommunications centre, operating from the World War I period for 82 years until 1999.









A piece of Budapest's history

Construction of the Telecommunications Palace began in 1910 to the designs of Rezső Vilmos Ray, a renowned architect of the time. The architect created a building that was innovative and unique in every respect, balancing on the boundary between historicism and art nouveau, and an early example of Hungarian reinforced concrete architecture. In July 1917, the Joseph Telephone Centre moved into one of the finest buildings of its time. The left wing housed the switch rooms, where the switchboard operators connected calls, while the right wing housed the engineering and management offices. Horses and carriages were stationed in the enclosed courtyard where the reception is now.

The 2nd largest historical staircase in the country

The old exterior of the originally elegant building has been restored to its original splendour by its Spanish owners and opened as a luxury venue in autumn 2020. One of the most beautiful parts of the hotel is the stunning historical staircase, faithfully restored to its original state, which is the second largest staircase in Hungary after the Parliament. In addition to the restoration of the original stair treads, floor tiles and columns, the painted coffered ceiling, the reconstruction of the candelabra and mouldings, and the re-crafting of the Zsolnay tiling of the staircase were all crafted by hand.







The common areas of the building, with its French courtyard, are characterised by spaciousness, exceptionally high ceilings, modern furniture and minimalist decoration. The design furniture was custom-made in Spain, based on individual designs, especially and exclusively for the Kozmo Hotel. The rooms and common areas are decorated with unique photographs of Budapest by Spanish photographer Carlos Cánovas, while the courtyard and lobby are decorated with works by painter and sculptor Lluis Lleo.

An oasis of undisturbed relaxation

Kozmo is an intimate secret garden in the heart of the city - thanks to the location tucked away from prying eyes, it offers perfect recreation. The rooms and suites have been designed with the ultimate relaxation in mind, and Kozmo offers king-size beds in rooms with unprecedented spaciousness and extra soundproofing for a downtown venue. The elegant hotel offers 61 rooms in 3 categories (standard, superior, deluxe) and 23 spacious suites (standard, junior, grand deluxe and presidential), some of which also have a private spacious terrace with a unique view. Bathed in natural light thanks to large windows, the rooms are decorated in a minimalist yet luxurious style, with comfortable furnishings, Penhaligon's bathroom fittings and extra amenities to make you feel at home. Rooms range from 32 to 45 square metres in floor space, suites from 47 to 190 square metres, and all suites have walk-in wardrobes, bathtubs and rainfall showers. The Kozmo's award-winning minibar offers a wide selection of choices.









Outstanding Gastronomic and Spa Experiences

Guests from all over the world are welcomed at Kozmo's reception with sparkling wine and scones and 24-hour reception service. The Bistro bar during the day and the Kozmo Restaurant in the evening offer Hungarian and international cuisine of the highest quality. The rich breakfast buffet, which includes an à la carte menu, offers pastries and cakes freshly prepared by the in-house pastry chefs. From May to October, the cosy courtyard is the ideal setting for an open coffe or cocktail.









The hotel's Valmont Spa is named after the Swiss luxury cosmetics brand used for facials and massages. It offers facial and body treatments, a 17-metre swimming pool, relaxation area, a pool-sized jacuzzi, a large sauna and a rainfall shower. The Spa, which is also open to external guests with a day pass, has a well-equipped gym with high standard Technogym equipment and refreshments always available.

A venue for unforgettable events

The Kozmo also offers a range of excellent event venues, whether it's a family or friends meeting, a wedding, a ball, a workshop or a conference. The 4 naturally-lit conference rooms with moveable walls, equipped with event technology, can accommodate up to 200 people.







The quiet Library Room offers a pleasant atmosphere and is suitable for meetings and smaller events - family and staff parties - but is also ideal for welcome drink sessions before larger events. In the evenings, the atmosphere is enhanced by a spectacular fireplace.



Other venue options for unforgettable events include the varied floor plans of the suites and their spacious terraces, the historic main staircase, the inner courtyard and the elegant Kozmo Restaurant.
